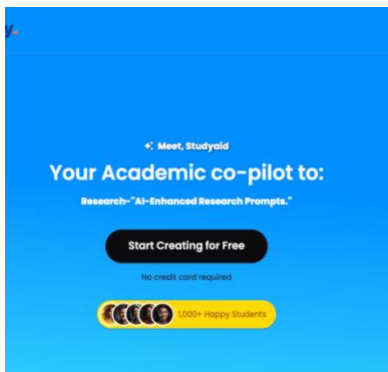


GETTING STARTED WITH STUDYAID – GUIDE FOR PROFESSORS


How to Create Account, Use AI Assistant, & Generating Student Access Codes

PART 1: Creating an Account

1. Create an account in StudyAid [<https://studyaid.store/>]



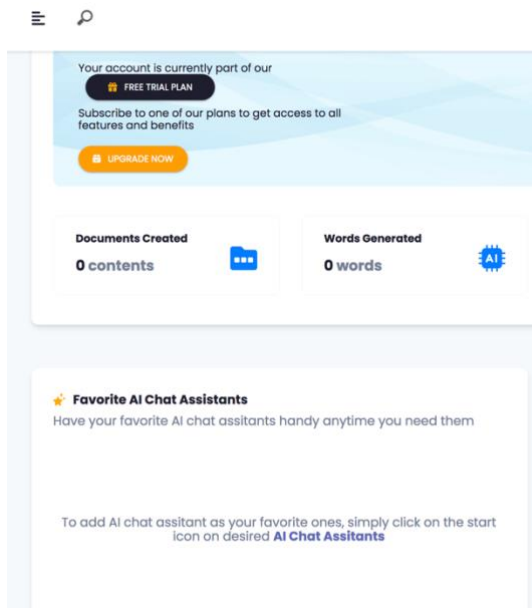
2. Select "Professor" as user option

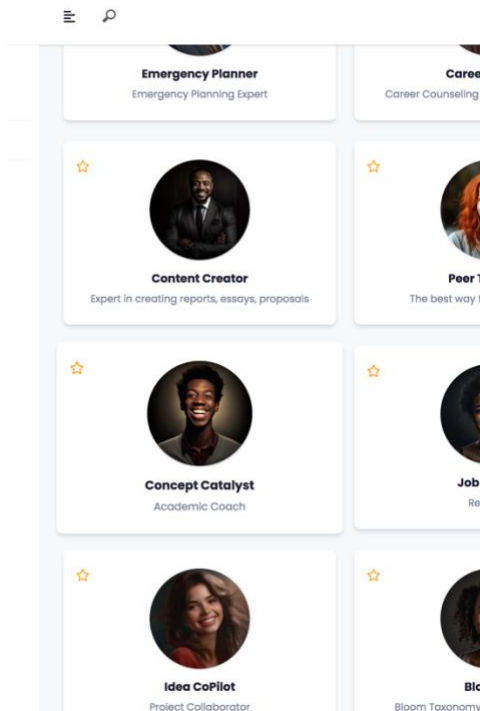
3. Fill in pertinent information
4. Login and begin to discover what StudyAid can do!

PART 2: Using StudyAID Chat Assistants

1. Click on “Favorite AI Chat Assistants”



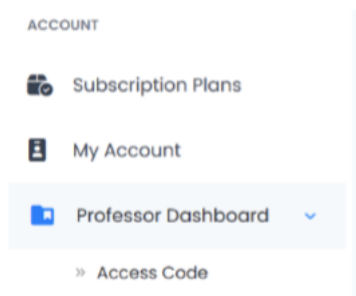
2. View list of AI Chat Assistants, select desired chat assistant



3. Start chatting with the AI assistant by prompting it with questions. (Tip: The more information and context you give the AI assistant, the more detailed its responses will be.)

PART 3: How to Generate Access Codes for Your Students

1. Submit a form to StudyAid at info@studyaids.com to request access codes for students. Include the following information:
 - a. Number of students
 - b. Student name (Last, First)
 - c. Title of class
2. Once access codes are received, log into StudyAid account
3. Navigate to “Professor Dashboard”
4. Click on “Access Code”



5. Copy the access codes and send to your students. Have them create an account on www.studyaids.com, and students can apply the access code to their account. (1 access code per student)
6. Once the student has applied their access code to the account, you will be able to see a list of students who have successfully completed their access code by again going to, “Professor dashboard”, and clicking access code. (As shown in steps 3 &4)
