PART 1: Creating an Account

1. Create an account in StudyAid [https://studyaid.store/]



2. Select "Professor" as user option



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
2. View list of AI Chat Assistants, select desired chat assistant



3. Start chatting with the AI assistant by prompting it with questions. (Tip: The more information and context you give the AI assistant, the more detailed its responses will be.)

PART 3: How to Generate Access Codes for Your Students

- Submit a form to StudyAid at <u>info@studyaid.store</u> to request access codes for students. Include the following information:
 - a. Number of students
 - b. Student name (Last, First)
 - c. Title of class
- 2. Once access codes are received, log into StudyAid account
- 3. Navigate to "Professor Dashboard"
- 4. Click on "Access Code"



- Copy the access codes and send to your students. Have them create an account on <u>www.studyaid.store</u>, and students can apply the access code to their account. (1 access code per student)
- 6. Once the student has applied their access code to the account, you will be able to see a list of students who have successfully completed their access code by again going to, "Professor dashboard", and clicking access code. (As shown in steps 3 &4)
